Cremation Authorization: The Owner hereby authorizes the Mortuary to arrange the cremation of the remains of the Pet using the services at the Cemetery. In providing this authorization, the undersigned represents that he or she is the Owner or the legal representative of the Owner and has full right and authority to arrange the cremation and disposition of the cremated remains.

Cremation Process: Undersigned acknowledges that due to the nature of the cremation process, any material on the remains of the Pet collars, tags, ECT, will be destroyed if not removed. Accordingly, the undersigned understand it will either be destroyed or removed and disposed of by the crematory. I further acknowledge: The pet's body burns with casket, container, or other material in the cremation chamber. Some fragments are not combustible at the incineration temperature, and as a result, remain in the cremation chamber. During the cremation, the continents in the chamber may be moved to facilitate incineration. The chamber is composed of ceramic or other material which disintegrates slightly during cremation and the product of that disintegration is commingled with the cremate remains. Nearly all of the continents of the cremation chamber consisting of the cremated remains, disintegrated chamber material, and small amounts of residue from previous cremations, are removed together, and are crushed, pulverized, or ground to facilitate internment or scattering. Some residue remains in the cracks and uneven Places of the chamber. Periodically The accumulation of this residue is removed and disposed of.

Disposition of cremated remains: The undersigned will pick up the cremains within 31 days. After 30 days a storage fee of \$20 A WEEK will be added. After 90 days all materials, cremains, and belongings associated with the pet and owner/s will be DISCARDED. Cremains will be given back approximately 31 working days.

Certification: The undersigned certifies the accuracy of all the information on this Authorization and will indemnify and allow Mortuary and Crematory, their owners, employer, and agents, from any liability, cost, expenses or claims resulting from Authorization and releases thereon.
